Assessment Teams Task Outcomes

Track 1

- Outcome 1: Team members will review a list of the SLOs currently being used across all of the campuses for each Core course in their assigned Core area/subject area.
 - Documentation/Resources: SLO/NM HED Area Maps, UNM/NM HED Areas & Competencies, and Bloom’s Taxonomy Domains
- Outcome 2: Team members will select a standard set of SLOs for each Core course from a preexisting list of SLOs. After reviewing the list, the teams will choose and/or provide a set of 3-10 Core course SLOs that will be measured and reported on by all campuses.
 - Complete SLO/NM HED Area Map template located on the USB Flash Drive provided to the Team Captain
 - SLOs should be written using the correct format: “By the end of the course, students will be able to...”

Assessment Teams Task Outcomes

Track 2

- Outcome 1: Team members will participate in discussions and/or complete steps for identifying, addressing, streamlining, administering, and/or implementing assessment-related projects.

Team Chairs

- Act as the group's facilitator in order to ensure that the goal and task outcome(s) are met
